The exams of the first semester take place in January and February, the exams of the second semester take place in June and July. Grading System	The Italian Grading System ranges from 18/30 to 30/30. The highest mark is 30/30 with distinction (lode). Exams under 18/30 are considered as "not passed" and can be registered on the final transcript of records on request.
Linguistic Center (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo – CLA)	Students can attend courses of languages at the University Linguistic Center. The fist Italian course is free for Erasmus students. Nomination Deadlines	31/05/25 first semester/ all year 31/10/25 second semester via mail to: incoming@scienze.unifi.it	
Application Deadlines	30/06/25 first semester/ all year 30/11/25 second semester via EWP and mail: incoming@scienze.unifi.it The necessary documentation for the application will be communicated to the student at the moment of the Nomination.	
Registration in Florence	At their arrival students must end the registration process contacting the International Relations Office of the School of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences. Students will receive the matricola number and the credentials for online services.	
Transcript of Records	At the end of their mobility period students must contact the International Relations Office of the School of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences to communicate their departure and to check the exams registered. The Transcript of Records will be sent to the home institution by mail.
